### APPLICATION

**WHERE and WHAT:** **Work team #14** will be flying into Cap Haitien, Haiti, then off to the village of Batso, in the northern mountains to the "Children of the Redeemer" Orphanage and school.

The work team will be construction school benches, working on door passages, furniture and any remaining work at the Batso orphanage. Details remain to be finalized.

**OUR MISSION:** To assist Pastor Kelly Augustin, and other church leaders in the Haitian community, to help meet the spiritual, physical and educational needs of adults and children and to best reach their communities with the good news of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

**REGISTRATION COST:** **\$850.** This includes transportation in Haiti, vehicle rentals, fuel, room, board, taxes, as well as funds for construction, and travel insurance.

Each work team member is responsible to pay for their own airfare to Cap Haitien, medical costs in the U.S. (Malaria medication, Tetanus, hepatitis shots, and all other vaccines and medications deemed necessary by your primary doctor and/or Travel Clinic.)

Incidental or personal funds for crafts, souvenirs, etc. are also not covered in the Reg. fee.

**DEPOSIT:** Full registration fee of **\$850 due January 1, 2019**

**AIRFARE:** We will purchase the plane tickets on or near December 15, 2018. Each work team member will reimburse HELP Mission Int'l., Inc. for the full amount by the end of September. The cost of tickets vary between \$500 and \$800.
