

INDOOR WORSHIP SERVICE

- 1.) Indoor Worship services will begin on October 4, 2020 with 2 services, at 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 in the Sanctuary
- 2.) Children's Church, and Youth Sunday School will be dismissed from the 10:30 Worship Service following the 1st song.
- 3.) No Nursery is provided at the present time.
- 4.) Pews and chairs will be marked at 6' apart
- 5.) Mandatory Face Masks
 - Unless: children under 2, or
 - Physical or mental health issues where it would endanger the wearer
- 6.) Social Distancing of 6 feet
 - Family groups may sit together
- 7.) Windows and doors will be open to increase ventilation.
- 8.) NO water fountain can be used.
- 9.) Procedure to deny access to positive or symptomatic individual
 - Symptoms to look : sweating, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, body aches or other symptoms consistent with fever, temp above 100.4 F, cough, congestion, sore throat, shortness of breath, headache, or new loss of taste or smell. If you have any of these symptoms, or feel sick, please stay home.
- 10.) if anyone has had COVID symptoms in the previous 14 days before attending a church service or has had a test positive for the virus they must stay home and notify the church.
- 11.) Procedure for responding to a positive case or outbreak
 - Including: Point of Contact to coordinate with RI DOH
 - For contact tracing
 - Case investigation

- Isolation and quarantine follow up
- 12.) The Deacons will register all names and numbers of everyone entering or being inside for more than 15 minutes, for contact tracing in case of an outbreak. [Information taken each Sunday]
 - 13.) Deacons will seat you in the Sanctuary.
 - 14.) Entry & Exit protocols must be established
 - Leave entry and exit doors open to reduce touching
 - Three doors, that are marked to enter and to exit.
 - Follow taped markings on the floor to indicate flow of traffic
 - No handshaking, hugging, kissing, nor hand holding
 - 15.) Screening is Required
 - Visual assessment, self-screening; cannot enter if they have been exposed within last 14 days
 - Plan to enter the Sanctuary:
 - Deacons will ask you a series of questions; have you read the COVID-19 poster? Do you have any symptoms?
 - If you have any symptoms or feel sick, you'll have to leave.
 - 16.) Posters or signs at entry educating individual of entry screening, social distancing, use of face covering, etc.
 - 17.) Please use hand sanitizing available before entering and when exiting
 - 18.) Restroom guidelines are posted near the entry and the restrooms.
 - 19.) Commonly touched surfaces must be cleaned/ disinfected before each use.
 - E.g.: Door knobs, pews, light switches, etc.
 - Bibles, Hymnals and cards will be removed from pews
 - 20.) No choir or musical ensembles; individuals singing must be 14 ft apart.

- Congregation can sing with their mask on
- 21.) No collection plates or any other object to be passed. Collection or Donation Boxes in a fixed location at entrance. We also encourage electronic payments, check instead of cash
 - 22.) We will use the overhead projector for music, Bible passages, and announcements. No paper handouts.
 - 23.) The service will be recorded and uploaded to Facebook and our website by 1:00 p.m.
